I'm Vivian Abdelmessih, Chair of EDC's Board of Directors.

In 2023 EDC served more than **27,000 customers** with our financial and knowledge solutions.

We facilitated more than \$131 billion in exports, foreign investment and trade development activities, more than \$27 billion of which was in emerging markets.

Trade is fundamental to Canada's economic prosperity.

Together, imports and exports represent 68 per cent of the country's GDP with exports specifically accounting for 34 per cent.

Still, only a small fraction of Canadian businesses are exporting imagine the transformative effect on our economy if more companies seized international opportunities.

Throughout 2023, EDC made significant strides toward our goal of growing Canada's exports by 60 per cent by 2030.

A third of the way through this ambitious strategy our focus remains on the same key elements.

Tailoring our support for the micro, small, medium and large segments so they can access the right supports at the right times.

Innovating digitally and culturally, to allow us to move at the speed of business.

Embedding ESG into everything we do to make Canada and the world more sustainable and inclusive through trade.

Our 2023 Integrated Annual Report details each of these key elements.

And the report goes beyond the data.

It tells the stories of Canadian companies that are growing sustainably and the positive impact they are making at home and abroad.

Because success is not just in the numbers.

It's also about the impact we make on Canadian businesses and communities.
